Special Election on Incorporation: “An election is hereby ordered to be held on May 10, 2008 in Fort Bend County, Texas for the purpose to confirm or deny the creation of the community of Weston Lakes as a Type B General-Law Municipality as required by Title 2, Chapter 7 of the Texas Local Government Code.” The Order of Special Election has been issued by Robert E. Hebert, County Judge of Fort Bend County. (The complete wording of the Order is on page 2 of this News & Updates edition.)

Early voting will be held in the Fort Bend County Precinct 3 Office Building beginning April 28th and ending May 6th. The voting on May 10th will be held at Huggins Elementary School. Those eligible to vote on this proposition are registered voters residing within the boundary of the proposed municipality (Weston Lakes including Riverwood Forest and the agricultural/ranch land east of Bowser Road to the Brazos River).

Town Hall Meeting on Incorporation: The POA will host a “Town Hall” meeting on the subject of Incorporation on Thursday, March 27th at 6:30 p.m. in the Country Club ballroom. The meeting is not to advocate either for or against the proposal to incorporate. Rather, the meeting will have two authorities to answer questions about incorporating as a municipality and what changes may or may not occur as a result. Mr. John Olson is an attorney with a practice in municipal law. Mr. John Clary is a retired official of the Texas State Office of Rural and Community Affairs who has also served in elected and appointed positions in city government and administration.

The POA asks that written questions for the panel be submitted by Friday, March 21st. Questions may be e-mailed to kelly@sterlingasi.com, dropped off at the POA office in the Welcome Center or mailed to POA, 5646 Weston Drive, Fulshear 77441. Written questions will be answered first in the meeting and then questions will be taken from the floor as time allows.
